GREEK SCHOOL NEWS by Rika Tsitsinia-Papadopoulos School Administrator & Development Director

Our new academic year has started and the classrooms and playground areas are buzzing from the voices of new and returning students. There is always so much joy in seeing old friends and catching up to all that happened during the summer!

We started our academic year with new school leadership. The retirement of our beloved Mrs. Theodora Kounalakis is now sinking in but her devotion and commitment will be inspiring us all as we go forward. We are blessed to have two new qualified, committed and enthusiastic staff to lead our school. Mrs. Katerina Papachristou-Chiotis has taken the role of Director. Katerina is certainly not new in our community as she has served as teacher almost continuously since January 1995. Ms. Rika Tsitsinia Papadopoulos has taken the newly created position of School Administrator & Development Director to be overall responsible for the school and to explore new initiatives.

Our school has welcomed almost 130 students in its 3 children's programs and 15 adults in the two adult sessions. We have 17 more children than last year and 7 more adults. We are also blessed to have 12 outstanding teachers - 7 returning and 5 new teachers. We welcome the following new teachers: Ioli Advani, Dimitra Armenaki, Bettina Iliopoulou, Dimitris Kagioulis, and Ioanna Vlachou. Our Greek school community reaches San Francisco to the north, Berkeley, Oakland and Fremont to the east, and Los Altos to the south! We are honored and humbled in the trust that all these families put in us and we are committed to serve them.

All three programs started with the Agiasmo service and Fr Peter and Fr Tom included the children in singing Kyrie Eleison. His Eminence Metropolitan Gerasimos and His Grace Bishop of Medeia Apostollos Koufallakis came to the first Agiasmo service and His Eminence spoke to the children about the importance of learning their faith, Greek language and heritage. We were also honored with a visit from the new Consul General of Greece Mr. Antonios Sgouropoulos who voiced his commitment to our community and the Greek school mission.

Enrollment in both the children and adult classes continues and we invite anyone who wants to visit our school before they decide to register or not to arrange for a visit day (or week) to see the wonderful learning environment and our outstanding and committed teachers in action. Visits are available to both children and adults.
